Regional Approved ALS Medication List

ALS personnel may administer medications in accordance with the Statewide BLS and ALS Protocols as adopted by Chester County and/or with on-line medical command direction. The following list represents the minimum list that all Chester County ALS level EMS agencies must carry. Those services may, in addition, also carry any other optional medication that is listed on the Statewide ALS Medication List, as published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. As the Chester County EMS Council, Inc. has not adopted Statewide Protocol # 4002 - Sedation Assisted Intubation, agencies may not carry Etomidate.
